Rules

General

- Runs from World Book Day 2026 to World Book Day 2027 (5 March 2026 – 4 March 2027)
- Books can be read in any order
- Open to everyone - family and children can join in!

Normal Mode

- Each book can count for up to 2 prompts, meaning a minimum of 12 books total
- Any format (print, eBook, audiobook, graphic novel)
- Re reads are allowed

Hard Mode

- All books must be new to you (but 1 re read is allowed)
- Each book counts for 1 prompt only, meaning a minimum 24 books total
